Palm City Boy Scout Max Pratt has achieved the rank of "Life Scout" and is working on becoming an "Eagle Scout." Max, 14, presented a proposal to the VFW Post House Committee describing his plan to beautify then front lawn with a memorial to veterans.

His tentative plan is to build a memorial garden with featuring engraved stones dedicated to each of the five branches of service, a bronze statue of a rifle, helmet and boots and a walkway to the garden with stones engraved with words like "hope", "courage" and "honor." He is also planning landscaping and park benches.

Max's ambitious plan must be approved by his Scout Council. He must design the project, solicit donations and materials to build the project and oversee teams of workers through completion of project.
